



BENDER Andrew Lee, MD of Philadelphia, PA, also of Woodcliff Lake, NJ, 76, son of I.B. and Lillian (nee Zebooker), and a direct descendant of the Baal Shem Tov, died Thursday September 5, 2013 at his residence.
